

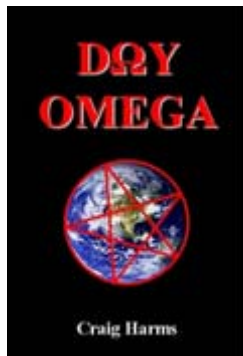

Sam Dimas lived a comfortable life in Chicago for years. Then the quest for more money, more stuff, more everything left him and his family with less of each other. The day he has a marriage-ending fight with his wife, is the day the world changes. In a flash, his wife and millions of people around the world disappear on what becomes known as Disappearance Day.

A new world rises. New leaders, new governments, new power, and people searching for answers tend to follow even the most ridiculous explanation for the human loss. Sam Dimas rises to a place of economic stability working for the company that develops and implements the microchip all remaining humans must have placed within their hands.
